

## Hemp Facts

- ✓ 50% of all agricultural pesticides and herbicides are used in the cotton industry. Hemp needs no pesticides or herbicides; its biggest enemy is man.
- ✓ Hemp fabric is 8 times more absorbent than cotton.
- ✓ The original Levi's were made from hemp.
- ✓ Hemp will outlast cotton 10-fold for durability.
- ✓ Hemp paper is a by-product of the textile industry.
- ✓ 1 acre of hemp will produce as much paper as 4 acres of trees.
- ✓ Hemp paper contains no dioxins or sulfur.
- ✓ Hemp paper can be recycled 7 times (3 for wood papers).
- ✓ Hemp paper has a shelf life of 1500 to 3000 years.
- ✓ Countries with legal industrial hemp are Holland, England, France, Spain and China.
- ✓ This paper is 50% hemp, 50% cereal straw.
- ✓ Hemp seeds were the number one food source for thousands of years.
- ✓ Hemp seeds are the most digestible form of protein known to man.
- ✓ Hemp seeds contain all 8 amino acids.
- ✓ Hemp seeds contain the highest amount of balanced essential fatty acids (E.F.A.'s)
- ✓ Hemp seeds are 30% to 50% oil by weight.
- ✓ When grown for seeds, half the plant's weight is seed.
- ✓ There has not been one single death from using hemp in 12,000 recorded years.
- ✓ Hemp has been used in traditional medicines for thousands of years.
- ✓ Hemp is preferred by cancer patients for nausea over harmful prescription drugs.
- ✓ Hemp has been known to stop a full-blown asthma attack.
- ✓ Anything made from petroleum can be made from hemp.
- ✓ The medicinal flower of the hemp plant is called marijuana.
- ✓ Industrial hemp has only trace amounts of T.H.C. (the 'high' compound)
- ✓ Hemp is the fastest growing plant on the planet.
- ✓ Hemp will grow anywhere that corn will grow.
- ✓ Hemp is illegal to grow.
